



## Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) Implementation Series #7 - FREE WEBINAR Outlining the Preliminary Draft of LCFS Regulations

On February 20<sup>th</sup>, CARB released a preliminary draft of the proposed rulemaking documents which they note covers a number of topics. The copy released last week will not be the official proposed rule and is still subject to change per the Office of Administrative Law review. The official proposal is set to be released on March 6, 2018 with the public comment period opening on March 9, 2018.

Note: There is a one year delay in the original verification timeline that CARB was discussing over the last year.

This, and other aspects of the proposed rulemaking will be discussed with our experts who are reviewing the preliminary draft in order to identify any major areas that may still need to be addressed through the public comment period. Our review and update will have a large focus on the addition of the third-party verification requirements, but will also make note of some other important areas in the regulation.
